

Dumitrache Silviu Valentin was born in 1992 in Bucharest, where he starts playing the piano at the age of five and plays for the first concert at the age of six.

In 1999 he is admitted at “*College National Dinu Lipatti*” in the class of Alma Peter Apostoleanu the first person that strongly marked his life.

In 2011, he graduates with the highest distinction in “*Art of Music*”.

From 2011 on, he started studying at *Koninklijk Conservatorium Brussel* with Prof. Daniel Blumenthal and Prof. Katia Veekmans, two world class teachers with whom he has a very good evolution and he graduates after three years “Bachelor in Music “Cum Laude”.

During his third year of Bachelor at KCB he meets with the pianist and teacher Gabriel Teclu who changes completely his musical conception. Starting the master at Conservatoire Royal de Bruxelles with Johan Schmidt and Gabriel Teclu he arrives in the final of Bluthner Competition in Brussels and in June 2016 he performs with the Liege Philharmonic Orchestra.

Today, he continues his studies at Conservatoire Royale de Bruxelles with Prof. Johan Schmidt and Assist. Gabriel Teclu.
